Keynote Speaker **Professor Nicolas Mottet**Professor of Urology, Jean Monnet University Saint-Etienne. France

Professor Nicolas Mottet, MD, PhD is board certified in surgery, urology and medical oncology. He is Professor of Urology, in the Jean Monnet University Saint-Etienne, France. He is chairman of the EAU Working Group on Prostate Cancer Guidelines, and member of the SIOG prostate and bladder cancer guidelines. He has published over 240 peer-reviewed papers, 33 book chapters and made numerous presentations and lectures; he is member of the Editorial Board of the European Urology Journal and of the Egyptian National Cancer Institute (JENCI) journal, and reviewer for many journals. He participated or coordinated more than 40 trials and received several national grants. He sits in the scientific committee of the APCCC since 2017. He is member of the AUA, AFU, ASCO, EAU, ESMO (where he sits in the scientific committee since 2020) and SIOG, senior faculty member of the European school of Oncology.

Professor Dr Ong Teng Aik
Consultant Urologist, University Malaya Medical Centre

Prof Ong is currently the President of the Malaysian Urological Association (MUA) and the Head of Department of Surgery, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur. Prof Ong is actively involved in a number of Asian multi-centre collaborative research activities, including the South East Asia Think Tank Group on Lower Urinary Tract Symptoms and the A-Cap Asia Pacific Prostate Cancer Registry. Together with the clinical oncologists, Prof Ong set up the first Uro-Oncology Combined Clinic in the University of Malaya Medical Centre, Kuala Lumpur, in 2010. The clinic had since been the model of how urologists could work together with the oncologists to improve patient care. Prof Ong's current research focus areas in uro-oncology are prostate epidemiology in Asia, the challenges faced in managing patients with localized prostate cancer in an Asian country, especially in decision making. Development of minimally invasive surgery in Malaysia is also another focus.



**Dr Yeoh Wei Sien**Consultant Urologist, University Malaya Medical Centre

Dr Yeoh is currently a board certified urologist working at the University of Malaya Medical Centre. He qualified as a medical doctor in 2005 before embarking on specialty training as a general surgeon in 2009 and went on to serve as a general surgeon in 2014 in Taiping before pursuing sub-speciality training in Urology. Dr Yeoh attained his urology diploma in 2017 and went on to do a fellowship in Melbourne Australia. In his current position, Dr Yeoh actively participates in training of undergraduate, post graduate as well as urology fellows as well as being involved in various clinical trials and studies.

Dr. Tan is currently a urologist in Sunway Medical Centre. He completed the Society of Urologic Oncology fellowship at the University of Toronto. He was also trained in robot-assisted surgery for prostate and kidney cancers. Dr. Tan is still actively involved in clinical research and welcomes research collaborations.
